

Create a Magazine

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Ask your English, Writing or Art students to create their own magazines. In my English Composition classes, I follow a creative approach to rhetorical modes, exposition, argumentation, description and narration. The minimum requirements for the magazine (which can be surpassed) follow. Students can work in groups or individually.

There should be no less than 5 articles, plus two rewritten in-class assignments.

The Magazine must have a front and back cover and a visible title.

The Magazine must have a page of contents, listing the articles and authors.

The articles must be polished, edited and closely proofread; no mistakes!!

Design and Layout (the visual creative part)

Your magazine needs to be legible and typed in the English language.

It cannot contain excessively violent images or pornography.

How you design your magazine is up to your student or group.

You can use photography, graphics, sketches, drawings, collages, your sister's yearbook cover, your mom's photo album, a pillowcase, etc.
