

Design Your Personality

Objective: Use a common object (a necktie) to create a design that expresses your unique personality.

Materials

- Heavy art paper cut into 11"x14"
- One or more of the following: ink, paint, pencil and/or collage
- Do not use a computer

Instructions

Trace the tie shape template onto the center of your 11"x14" piece of paper.

Create a design to fit entirely within the traced border that communicates who you are and what is important to you. Consider how you will use balance, harmony, rhythm, proportion and unity in your solution.

Securely tape an assignment project label on the back in the bottom left corner.

Written component: Assignment project label

On a sheet of white paper, type 125-150 words to explain how your solution expresses your personality. Describe how you used the design principles mentioned above to visually communicate who you are and what is important to you. Type your name in the top left corner.
