

Draw “Exhausted” Bags

Assignment: Drawing

Objective: Draw a group of three “exhausted” paper bags.

Materials: Graphite Pencil, 11”x14” Bristol or other heavy drawing paper, paper lunch bags or grocery bags

Instructions:

Arrange the paper bags to visually depict a feeling of “exhaustion.”

Produce a drawing that convinces a viewer of this feeling of exhaustion. Use line, shape, value, texture and space to guide your solution to this assignment.

Use the entire 11”x14” piece of paper, with no border.

Apply fixative (or hair spray) to prevent smearing. Do not mount your drawing.

You must draw from direct observation. Do not use a computer or a photograph.

Securely tape an assignment project label on the back in the bottom left corner.

Written component: Assignment project label

On a sheet of white paper, type 125-150 words to explain how your drawing shows “exhausted” paper bags. Describe the elements of art that you used to visually depict “exhaustion” in your bags. Type your name in the top left corner.
