The students are required to journal speech and communication events from classes, jobs, family or whatever.

We take some time to share these with each other about once or twice a quarter.

I am trying to make the learning in the course meaningful to use in everyday life and I want students to see speech-communication going on around them.

Hopefully, they will be more confident about the ability they have to speak up.
