An easy idea for fostering teamwork and practicing presentation skills: Periodically ask students to report on textbook chapters they have read in teams.

This ensures that students actually do read the textbook. Often, hearing the information from other students can give the class a new perspective, as the work is explained in fresh ways and in a recognizable framework coming from fellow students.

Students seem to actually like this process, as it gives them some ownership of the content as well as giving them an opportunity to practice their presentation skills.
